The Juried Exhibition will be on display from March 19 – April 23, 2021, awards will be announced Friday, April 9th. All work must have been completed for credit courses at TNCC between March 2020 – March 2021. Work should be properly documented and fit the appropriate submission guidelines, please see details in this prospectus for more information.

Submission Guidelines:

Students may submit two works for consideration. They must submit the Entry Form and their files as defined below. All entries must be submitted by March 12th, 2021

Image requirements for 2D and 3D work:

- Jpeg files with a minimum of 1200 pixels in width or height.
- Files should not exceed 5MB per image.

- Images should be labeled with artists name, entry number, and category (example: John_Doe_Entry 1_2D.Jpeg)
- For 3D work students may submit 2 additional detail images of their project. They should label these images as details (example John_Doe_Entry 1_Detail.jpg)
- Image should be in focus, evenly/well lit, and cropped to the edges of the work.
- All artwork must be original and done only by the student submitting it.

Requirements for Video, Animation, and Motion Graphics work:

- All artwork must be original and done only by the student submitting it.
- mov or mp4 files only in 1080 format: 1920 x 1080
- They should be no longer than 3 minutes and the file should not exceed 128 GB.
- Files need to be labeled with artists name, entry number, and category (example: Jane_Doe_Entry 1_Video.mp4)
